

LOCAL GOVERNMENT FEES AND CHARGES SET BY STATUTE 2018-19

The South Australian *Government Gazette* No. 37 of 31 May 2018 and No. 40 of 21 June 2018 set out new levels of fees and charges for 2018-19, which come into effect on 1 July 2018. For the seventh year in a row the LGA has arranged with the State Government for most of these fees to be indexed.

Note that some fees listed below may be applicable only to State agencies.

<p>1. Many of the development application fees shown below require Councils to provide a percentage distribution to the Development Assessment Commission. Updated details are advised via an Advisory Note issued by the Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure in June each year (telephone 8303 0601).</p> <p>2. Fees shown under Items 1(8) – Building Rules Fees are calculated under a formula (unless the minimum fee applies) which takes account of floor areas and complexity factors. The formula is set out in Schedule 6(1)(8) of the <i>Development Regulations 2008</i>.</p> <p>3. The <i>Development (Trusses) Variation Regulations 2011</i> under the Development Act results in significant costs for Councils in undertaking additional inspections to meet the requirement of these Regulations. The LGA has urged the State Government to establish appropriate fees to enable Councils to recover the additional costs of this regulatory work.</p>

Dog and Cat Management Act 1995

Section 26 of the *Dog and Cat Management Act 1995* allows councils to set their own fees for dog registration, subject to any limits that might be imposed by regulations. The Dog and Cat Management Board (DCMB) is of the view that councils should be able to set their own fees and does not support the making of such regulations. To date, no regulations have been made. So for the foreseeable future, councils have discretion to set their own fees for:

- provision of extracts from registers kept under the Act;
- the receipt and management of information relating to a register required by the Board. The DCMB does not recommend that Council set such a fee. The Dogs and Cat Online system was developed to facilitate owners self-managing their own records. Charging fees for updating information (whether the record is updated by the owner or a council officer) make it less likely the database will remain up to date.
- the registration of dogs or businesses;
- late payment of registration fees; and
- meeting any other requirements imposed on Councils under the Act.

Desexing and micro-chipping a dog must earn rebates on dog registration. A dog can receive both rebates if eligible. Councils, at their own discretion, may identify the rebate percentage. The DCMB recommends a 50% discount for a 'Standard Dog' (one that is microchipped and desexed). Councils have a discretion to offer other discounts for training, concession card holders, working livestock dogs or other policy reasons.

Fees for the registration of cats may be set in council by-laws, pursuant to section 90 of the *Dog and Cat Management Act 1995* and section 246 of the *Local Government Act 1999*.
