Unfortunately we are unable to accept delivery of artwork before these dates.

- All exhibits must be delivered to 4 Crescent Drive Norton Summit, at the artists' own expense.
- Any 2 Dimensional artworks that **cannot be hung** or 3 Dimensional artworks that **cannot be safely displayed** will not be accepted.
- All exhibits will remain on view, whether sold or not, until the close of the Art Exhibition.
- Each exhibit must have details attached to their work.
- Submitted artwork must correspond with the work that was provided on the entry form.
- Artists must sign that they have delivered their artwork & that it has been received.

Collection of artwork | Monday 28 August - Friday 1 September, 9am to 3pm

- All exhibits must be collected from 4 Crescent Drive Norton Summit, at the artists' own expense.
- Artists must sign that they have received their artwork or provide a signed authority if they wish a third party to collect on their behalf.

Sale of artwork

All artwork whether sold or not, must remain on view until the close of the exhibition. Customers interested in purchasing artwork will be provided with the contact details for the artist. **It is the artist's role to facilitate the sale.**

Sale of retail products

Regarding the sale of any associated products (e.g. greeting cards), the customer will be provided with the contact details or directed to the artist if they are present at the exhibition to facilitate the sale.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

SALA 2017



The following conditions apply to all exhibits and exhibitors.

1. The exhibition is open to established and emerging artists over 16 years of age.
2. The Summit Community Centre (TSCC) and the Adelaide Hills Natural Resource Centre (AHNRC) reserve the right to refuse or limit the overall number of entries.
3. Works that have previously been exhibited at The Summit Community Centre will not be accepted.
4. All exhibits must be the original work of the exhibitor and excludes reproductions, collaborative artists' works or any works produced with a tutor.
5. The artist's name, address and the price must be clearly printed on the back of each item.
6. All entries will be allocated a catalogue number on acceptance and this will be affixed to the individual exhibits on delivery.
7. Whilst the organisers will exercise all reasonable care at all times, no responsibility will be accepted for any lost or damaged exhibits.
8. It is recommended that suitable insurance cover be taken out at the expense of the artist for the duration of the exhibition.
9. For the proper and orderly conduct of the exhibition, TSCC and AHNRC reserve the right in its sole discretion to, at any time, without prior notice to the exhibitor, amend, alter, or vary any of the conditions of entry, or reject any entry which they consider does not fit with the general aims of the exhibition.
10. The artist will indemnify the Adelaide Hills Council, TSCC and AHNRC against any costs incurred by them (including legal fees and damages) in any way relating to the work and the display of the work in the exhibition, including claims of defamation, copyright infringements, intellectual property rights and claims for injury and property damage (including damage to or loss of the work itself).
11. Artists by entering work in the exhibition authorise TSCC and AHNRC, at their discretion, to allow any work to be reproduced in newspapers, magazines, the Art Show Catalogue, web pages or other media in the promotion of the art exhibition and sales of works.
12. The artist gives consent to Adelaide Hills Council to make, use and/or retain an image (digital photograph) or recording (video recording) that may identify them or their artwork. They allow the artist's name to be used in association with the use of the images or recording and understand that by giving consent, Adelaide Hills Council can use the images or recordings to promote activities. Adelaide Hills Council may reproduce the image or recording in any form, in whole or in part, and distribute the works by any medium including, the Internet, CD-ROM or other multimedia including The Summit Community Centre Facebook page.
13. Two Dimensional artworks (paintings, works on paper, photography etc.)
 - must not exceed a maximum size (including frame for paintings) of 1.5 square metres.
 - should be soundly framed in a professionally accepted practice, dry and ready to be hung (flat D-rings preferred).
14. Three Dimensional artworks (metal, stone, wood, glass, ceramics etc.)
 - must fit through a standard door when assembled.
 - the artist will need to supply their own supports and /or moving equipment for large heavy objects and either set the artwork up themselves or provide any set up instructions.
