## Yellow Lid Bin Recycling

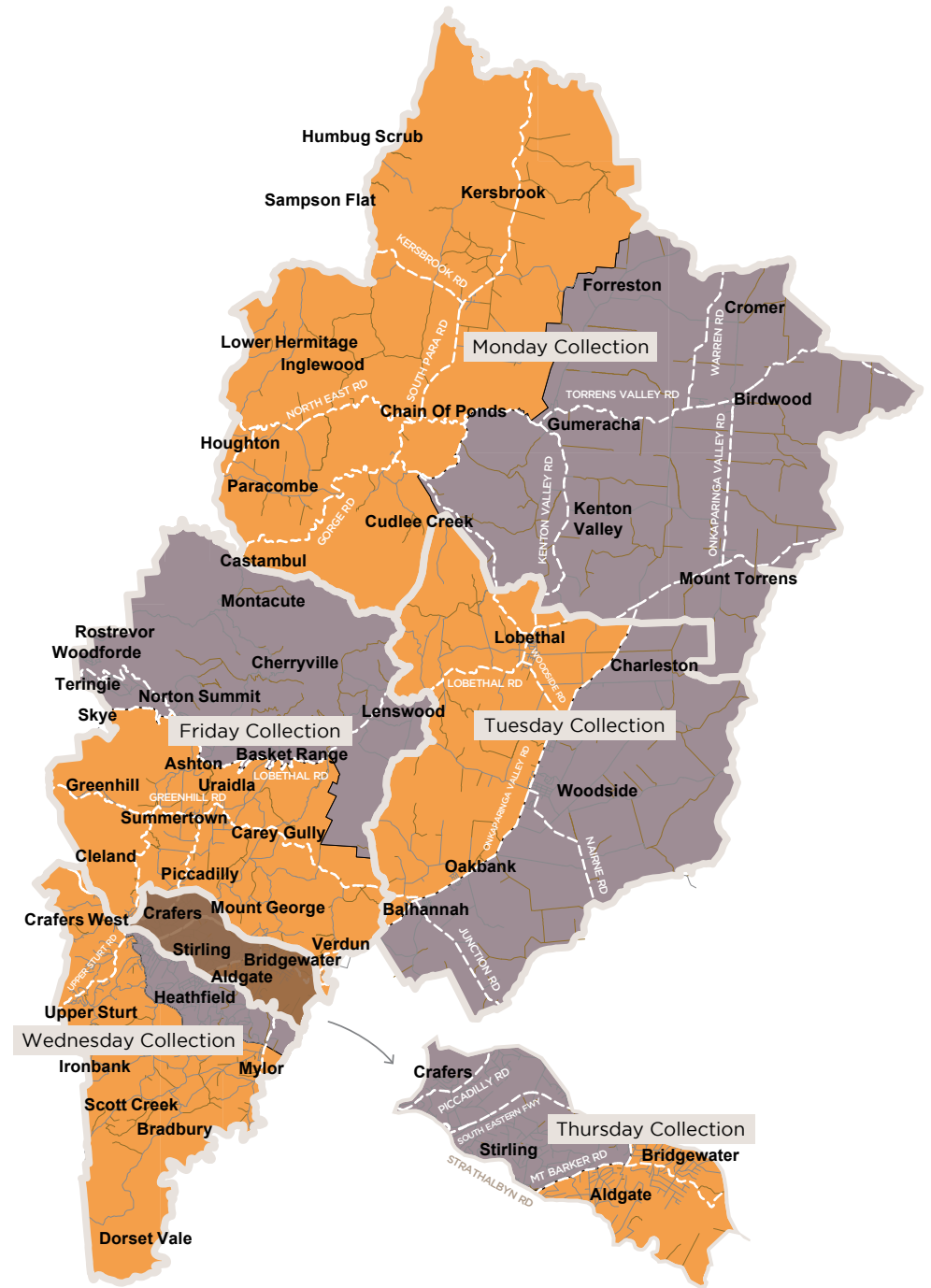
-  Tins and cans | glass bottles and jars | paper and cardboard | rigid plastics | metal lids | aerosols | foil trays | pots, pans and cutlery
-  Plastic bags and wrappers (cling film, newspaper wrap, bubble wrap) | clothes and fabrics | nappies | polystyrene foam | food scraps or organics | broken glass
-  Ensure bottles and containers are empty and rinsed
-  Items for recycling are processed into new products



## Green Lid Bin Organics (townships only)

-  Lawn clippings | garden prunings and small branches | leaves and twigs | food scraps | tissues and paper towels
-  Plastic bags | dirt, rocks and soil | gardening tools | irrigation pipes, hoses or plant pots | nappies | polystyrene
-  Only *compostable* bags should be placed in the organics bin
-  Organics for composting will be turned into nutrient rich soils

## Blue Lid Bin Waste

-  Polystyrene | broken glass | crockery and ovenware | nappies | clothes and textiles | soft plastics | plastic bags and wrappers
-  Food scraps | recyclables | electronic waste (e-waste) - disposal at Heathfield Resource Recovery Centre | light globes - disposal at selected hardware stores
-  Waste in blue bin goes to landfill



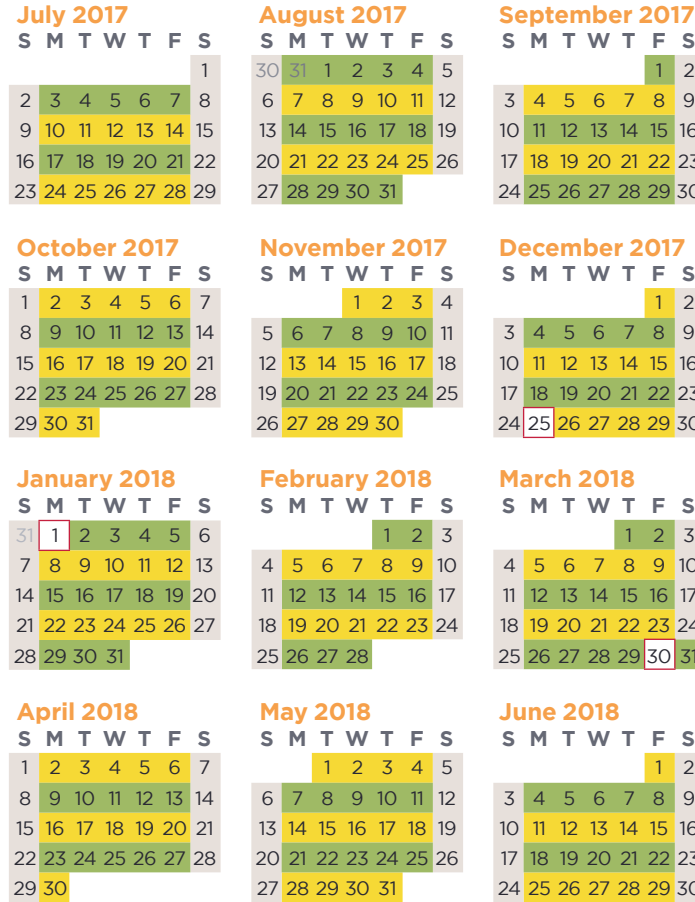
 Zone A     Zone B

### Kitchen Caddies

Collect food scraps and other selected waste in a kitchen caddy to help reduce your household contribution to landfill. Kitchen caddies can be collected from all Council Service Centres and are available to residents (one per residence) who have a kerbside green organics bin.

## Items that **must not** be placed in any bin

- Hazardous waste
- Lead acid batteries
- All liquid waste (including paint and oil)
- Medical waste
- Tyres
- Fluorescent lighting
- Electronic equipment (e-waste)
- Building and construction waste (steel, concrete, bricks, timber, rubble, rocks and earth)

Blue lid bin collected weekly

Yellow lid bin collected fortnightly

Green lid bin collected fortnightly (townships and urban areas only)

No collection on Christmas Day, New Years Day and Good Friday. Pick up will occur the following day.

**No collections on catastrophic fire days.**  
**Kerbside bins will be collected on the next non-catastrophic fire day.**
