



# Extension of Time Request Form

## Application for Extension of Time pursuant to Regulation 48 (*Development Regulations 2008*).

Development Plan and Building Rules Consents have an operative time period of 12 months. If Development Approval has not been issued within this time or work has not commenced following Development Approval and you wish to keep the approval valid, a request to Council for an extension of time is required.

The following will be considered in the assessment of a request to extend the operative period of the relevant Development Plan Consent/Building Rules Consent/Development Approval:

- Have the Development Plan provisions changed since the granting of Development Plan Consent and, if so, what implications would result from the change(s); and
- Reasons why the Planning Consent / Development Approval has not been acted upon; and
- The extent of progress made towards acting on the relevant Planning Consent / Development Approval; and
- Whether anybody will suffer prejudice if the extension of time is granted.

When applying to Council for an extension of time to a Planning/ Building Consent / Development Approval issued by Council please complete this form and submit along with payment of \$102.00. Please note, the application will not be considered until the required fee is paid in full.
