

BRIDGEWATER – 2

From the car park (at *THE DEANERY*) at the end of the OLD MOUNT BARKER ROAD, proceed towards the M1 South Eastern Freeway (along the wide dirt track) then pass through the tunnel and continue straight ahead along the track (through the MT. GEORGE CONSERVATION PARK, following the fence line to the right) then follow the road (Mt. GEORGE ROAD) to MULLER ROAD (on the right). Follow this road (passing WORDEN ROAD and some interesting moss rock directly opposite that road) to the CAREY GULLY-BRIDGEWATER ROAD, then go left and follow this road to RANGEVIEW ROAD (passing *Badenoch Road* on the right). At Rangeview Road, go left and follow the road verge to the next road on the right (BOWLING GREEN ROAD). At the bottom of the hill, go left onto GULLY ROAD then follow this narrow winding road to the junction with Rangeview Road and OLD CAREY GULLY ROAD. Continue along Old Carey Gully Road, pass the Mt Lofty Golf Course on the left and SPRING GULLY ROAD (on the right) to go left on GOLFLINKS ROAD. Follow this roadway to the stone gateway of the Mt LOFTY GOLF LINKS (on the left, directly opposite HOYLAKE AVENUE) but continue along Golflinks Road for approximately another 80 meters to a wide track on the left (almost opposite St. ANDREWS AVENUE). At the end of this track, follow the LEAH FIRE TRACK to TIMBERSUTTERS TRAIL (on the left) but continue straight ahead to GATE 13 and the CASCADE TRAIL on the left. Follow this trail down the hill (note waterfall on the right during winter) until you arrive at another trail junction (a trail on the left and a sign CASCADE TRAIL on the right). Continue down the hill for approximately 150 meters, cross the little wooden bridge then continue to the next big wooden bridge (over Cox Creek). On the other side of the creek, at the intersection of four trails, go right and follow the trail to the Freeway tunnel (after crossing another little wooden bridge) for the trek back to the start.
