

LENSWOOD

This walk, with very long, steep grades, is through the heart of the principal apple growing area of South Australia.

From the corner of SWAMP ROAD and ADELAIDE-LOBETHAL MAIN ROAD head south along Swamp Road to LESLIE ROAD (*on the right*). Just beyond the little bridge across the creek, this narrow winding road is very steep climb for just over one kilometer before the descent to the Adelaide-Lobethal Road. Here, go left and follow the wide road verge for just a short distance to STENTIFORD ROAD (*on the left*) then, after another steady climb you will arrive at the junction of POLLARD ROAD. Go left and continue along Stentiford Road for a one kilometer steep descent to Swamp Road (*passing Collins Road on the right*). At Swamp Road (*by Fred's Tank – a big water tank*) go left for the return trek to the starting point.
