

Santos Women's Tour Down Under 2019

Stage 1: Finish – Shannon St, Birdwood

Complete road closures – Thursday 10 January 2019

- Shannon St, Birdwood
 - Complete closure from Blumel Rd to the National Motor Museum entrance between 10:30am - 3:30pm*
 - Complete closure from Blumel Rd to Lange Cres from 1:30pm – 2:00pm*

*These closure times have been put in place for public safety and to allow set up and pack down of event infrastructure. However, we would expect to commence reopening of roads prior to this time.

Rolling road closures

The remainder of the event circuit outside of the complete closures listed above will operate under **'rolling' road closures** managed and enforced by SA Police and supported by trained traffic marshalls.

Parking restrictions

No roadside parking will be permitted on Shannon St between Blumel Rd and #27 Shannon St to allow installation of finish line infrastructure.

Santos Men's Tour Down Under 2019

Stage 2 of the Men's race will be completing a sprint through Birdwood on Wed 15 January. This sprint will operate using only temporary rolling road closures managed by SA Police. Parking restrictions will be in place along Shannon St from the night before to allow the National Motor Museum to install a display of vintage and classic cars along the route.

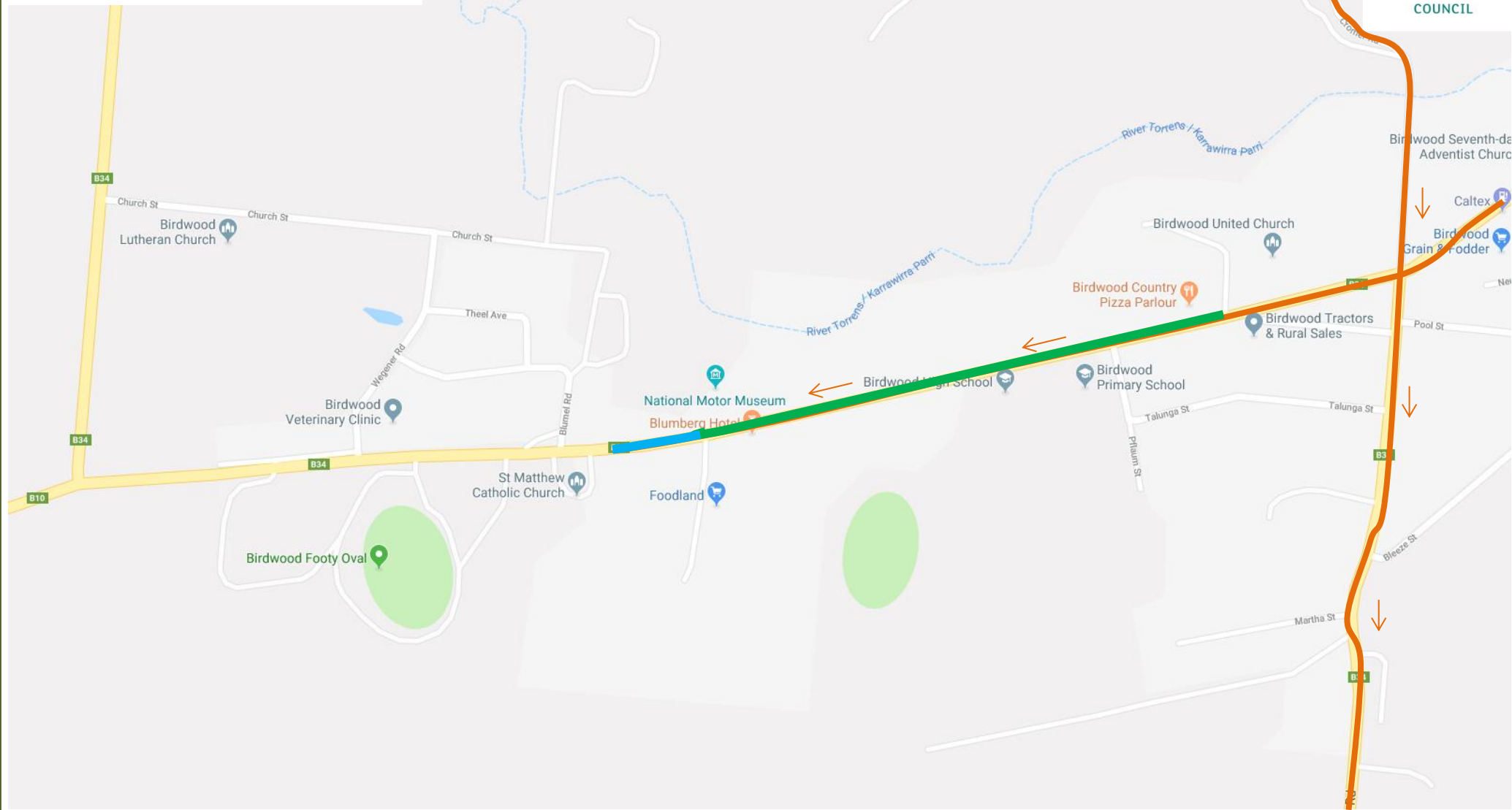
