Stage 4: King of the Mountain - Corkscrew Rd

Complete road closures - Friday 18 January 2019

- Corkscrew Rd, Montacute
 - No parking entire length of road from 9:00am
 - Complete closure Gorge Rd to Montacute Rd between 12:00pm - 3:30pm*
- Church St, Montacute
 - Closed to public traffic from 9:00am. Residents will permitted access and egress until 12:00pm
 - Complete closure from 12:00pm – 3:30pm*

*These closure times have been put in place for public safety and to allow set up and pack down of event infrastructure. However, we would expect to commence reopening of roads prior to this time.

Rolling road closures

The remainder of the event route outside of the complete closures above will operate under **'rolling' road closures** managed and enforced by SA Police and supported by trained traffic marshalls.

Parking restrictions

No parking will be permitted along the length of Corkscrew Rd from 9:00am – 3:30pm.

EastWaste will be deploying additional vehicles and collecting earlier than normal on Friday 18 January. Please ensure your bins are ready for collection on Thursday night and bring your bins in off the roadside as soon as possible.

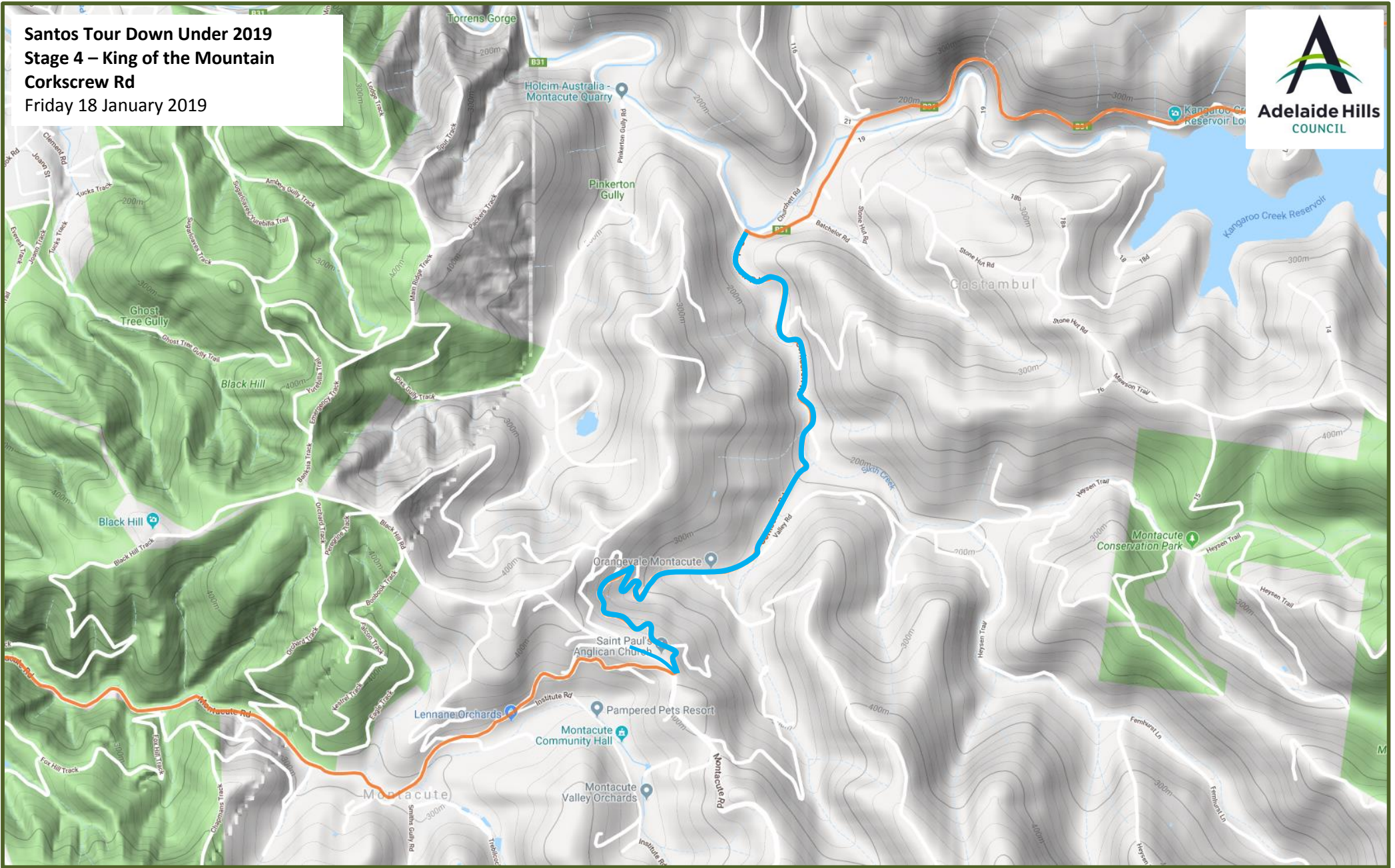
