The Santos Tour Down Under is returning to Corkscrew Road on Friday 18 January 2019 for the Stage 4 'King of the Mountain' challenge.

Making their way from Unley to Campbelltown, riders will begin the last leg of the day by tackling the famous Corkscrew Road climb and flying down Montacute Road to the finish line.

To enable the event to run smoothly and safely, a number of parking and traffic restrictions will be implemented on the day, including the closure of Corkscrew Road between 12:00pm – 3:30pm. Enclosed are the full details of the race route and restrictions in the area. Please familiarise yourself with these restrictions and plan your day accordingly. Outside of these restrictions, South Australia Police will manage traffic using 'rolling road closures' and access for emergency services will remain at all times.

EastWaste will be deploying additional vehicles and collecting waste earlier than normal on Friday 18 January. Please ensure your bins are ready for collection on Thursday night and bring your bins in off the roadside as soon as possible on Friday.
